Bilpin's Apple Pie Trail brings together all that we love about this area. Famous for its apples and cool climate, Bilpin is a fruit lovers dream.

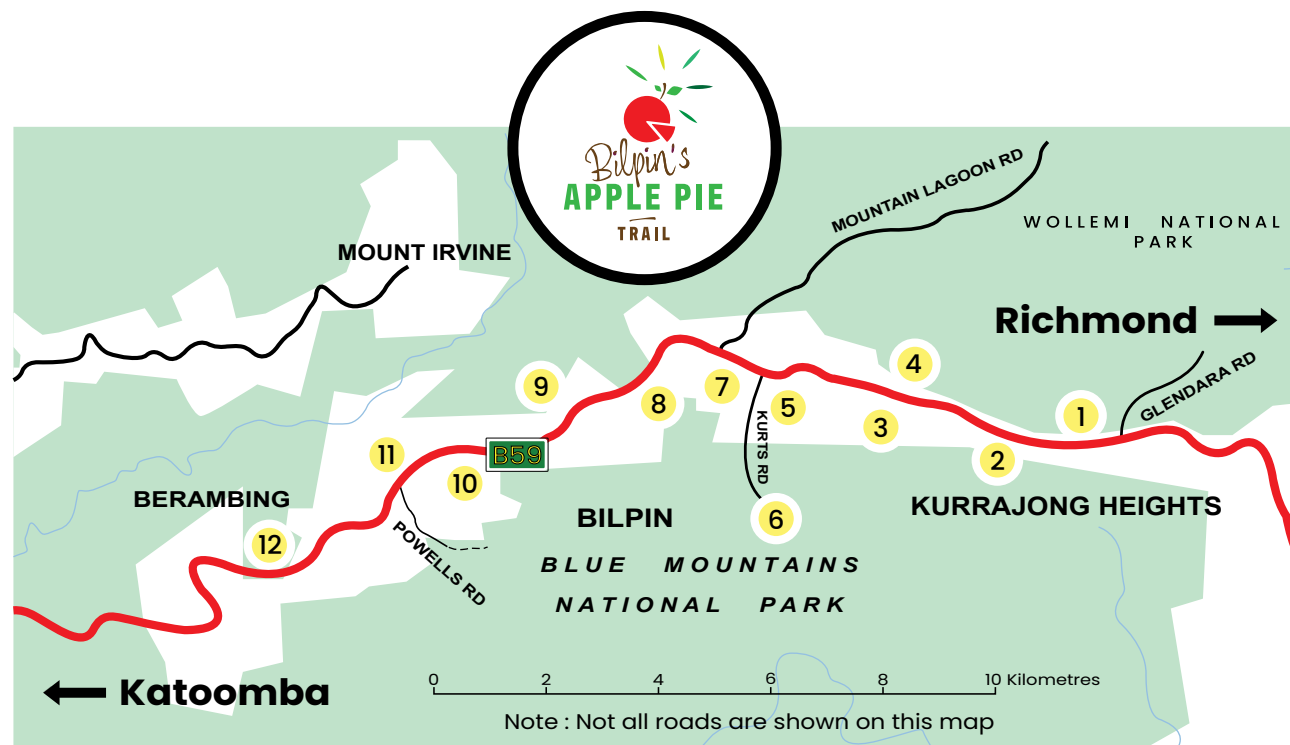
What better way to sample the local produce than through a locally made hot apple pie.
